Bio waste

Collection: each week



This goes into the brown bin:

Kitchen and garden waste
Flowers
Bread and cake leftovers
Egg-shells and bones
Meat and fish (cooked)
Cheese and cold meat leftovers

Fruit
Vegetables and salads
Leftovers from meals
Tea bags and coffee filters
Used pizza boxes
...

Tip: Collect the bio waste in paper bags or wrap it up in newspaper.

This doesn't go in:

Rubbish bags of plastic or bio-foils
products marked as compost-capable
such as coffee capsules, coffee mugs,
disposable cutlery/crockery,
cat litter, raw meat
...

Paper and cardboard

Collection: every 14 days

This goes into the blue bin:

Files made of cardboard
Writing paper and envelopes
Books and notepads
Printer paper
Egg boxes and folding boxes
Gift-wrap

Catalogues and brochures
Cardboard
Packing paper and corrugated cardboard
Newspapers and magazines
clean pizza boxes
...

This doesn't go in:

Photos
Beverage boxes
Wallpaper
Till receipts (residual waste)
...

Recycling bin

Collection: every 14 days
Remondis area: Telephone 0251/92 43 60 11, AWM area: Telephone 0251/605253

This goes into the melon coloured bin:

All waste of metal, plastic and compounds
Metal: aluminium foils and dishes,
cutlery, beverage and food cans,
crown caps, pots

Plastic: yoghurt pots,
watering cans, coffee capsules, bios,
bowls, toys, toothbrushes
Compounds: disposable shavers, milk
and juice containers
...

This doesn't go in:

Glass
Bicycle hoses or tyres
Porcelain
Electrical devices
Diapers
Batteries
...

Residual waste

Collection: every 14 days

This goes into the grey bin:

Ash and sweepings
Sanitary pads and tampons
Baking paper
Fish and meat leftovers (raw)
Plaster and rubber
Light bulbs
Till receipts
Cat litter and bird grit
Ceramic and porcelain
Candles
Adhesive labels
Condoms
Cosmetic towels

Leather remains
Plasters and bandaging material
Cleaning rags
Vacuum cleaner bags
Wallpaper
Diapers
Cotton wool
Cigarette ends and ash
...

This doesn't go in:

Building rubble and stones
Electrical devices
Problematic waste

Bulky refuse

This can be put by the road:

Furniture and household:
Beds, mattresses and slatted frames
Ironing boards and brooms
Couch
Small animals' cages
Prams
Suitcases (without contents)
Ladders
Cabinets and sideboards
Armchairs, settees, chairs and tables
Carpets/floor coverings
(rolled up or tied up)
Clotheshorses
...

Garden and patio:
Flower boxes, garden devices
Garden waste (in town bags)
Plastic garden furniture
Shrub cuttings (tied up)
Other bulky refuse:
Bicycles (with "bulky refuse" sticker)
Blinds and window shades (indoor)
...

This will not be picked up:

Car parts, baths,
electrical devices, mirrors,
toilets, pallets,
timber treated with protection agent,
boxes, cardboard
clothes, buckets of paint
...

Large electrical devices

This will be picked up:

Collection: registration card free of charge (only private households)

Fridges and freezers
Televisions
Washing machines
Cooker
Dishwashers
Tumble dryers
Computer monitors
...

This will not be picked up:

Small and medium-sized devices like fans, vacuum cleaners, mobility scooters, fume extractors, microwaves

hand in free of charge at the recycling yard

Small electrical devices

This goes into the containers for electrical devices:

Radios

This doesn't go in:

Batteries and rechargeable batteries (due to risk of fire, please remove beforehand and hand in at the recycling yard or a shop)
large and medium-sized devices
...

Waste glass

This goes into the bottle bank:

Throw-in Times: Mo – Sa from 7 – 20 h

separated as white or coloured glass
empty glass bottles
empty glass containers

This doesn't go in:

Fire-proof glass (e.g. coffee decanter)
Window glass
Glass bricks
Large glasses (recycling yard)
Full bottles
